

EASY TO FOLLOW ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Purchase a **1/2" three-ring binder (white with view pockets)**.
2. Print the file, 3 hole punch the content and place it in the rings.
3. Insert the cover page into the front view window of the binder. NOTE: Do not hole punch the cover page because it will look really stupid and that reflects negatively on both of us.
4. Print the spine insert on the following page of this file, trim the left and right sides off just enough to exclude the dashed lines from the center strip then insert the center strip into the spine view window of the binder. NOTE: This can actually be a somewhat difficult task. Place a nail file in between the paper strip and the binder spine then... well, it will come to you instinctively. You'll figure it out.

The finished product will look very similar to an actual book then just use your imagination from there and pretend it's a book, amaze your friends and impress girls with hours of good wholesome family fun and entertainment.
